FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

June 2020

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **75** calls for service; **51** incidents were for emergency medical and **24** incidents were suppression-related. BLS care was rendered on **16** incidents while ALS care was rendered on **35** calls. The remaining medical did not require medical care. Station 36 responded to **52** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **0** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **12** calls within the Southeast Area and **18** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **105** calls.

Calls of Interest:

- June 6th- Ambulance 36 responded into Wheeling on a Box Alarm. While on this assignment they transported 1 Pt. to Glenbrook Hospital.
- June 14th Tender 36 responded into Barrington Hills for a structure fire. Tender 36 shuttled 5 loads (16,000 gallons) of water.
- June 16th Tender 36 responded to a structure fire in Indian Creek and shuttled water. This location is just west of Mundelein.


