FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE REPORT

July 2021

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **85** calls for service; **57** incidents were for emergency medical services and **28** incidents were suppression related. BLS care was rendered on **26** incidents while ALS care was rendered on **28** calls. The remaining EMS calls did not require medical care. Station 36 responded to **36** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **0** calls in the Barrington-Countryside FPD side of Inverness.

Calls of Interest

- July 4th Engine 36 responded to a MABAS Box-Alarm fire in Carpentersville. Crew performed exterior suppression work.
- July 7th Ambulance 36 assisted Palatine FD with a multi-vehicle motor vehicle crash with entrapment. One subject was transported by our ambulance crew.
- July 9th Engine 36 responded for a garbage truck entangled in overhead wires. E36 assessed the scene for hazards and secured the area until Groot and ComEd were able to mitigate the situation.
- July 19th Engine 36, Ambulance 36 and D/C Mohr responded to a multi-vehicle crash on Palatine Road. Crews found 3 vehicles off the roadway with one of them overturned in a wooded area. The extrication required not only removing the injured subject from the car, but removing several small trees and brush in order to gain access.


