FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

September 1-24, 2020

This month's activities resulted in Station 36 responding to **68** calls for service; **48** incidents were for emergency medical and **20** incidents were suppression-related. BLS care was rendered on **10** incidents while ALS care was rendered on **38** calls. The remaining medical did not require medical care. Station 36 responded to **42** calls within our section of the Village of Inverness and **0** calls in the other side of Inverness. The District logged **9** calls within the Southeast Area and **17** incidents in all other contract areas for an overall total of **94** calls.

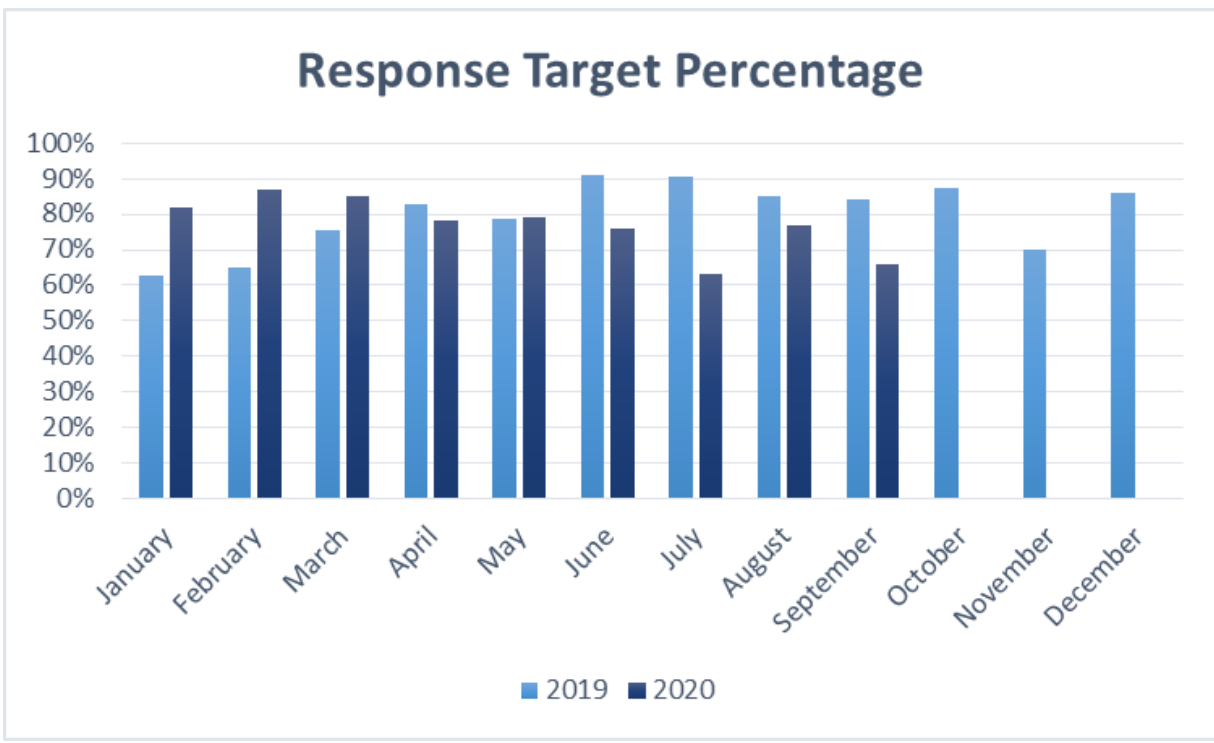
