MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE INVERNESS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT HELD THE 11th DAY OF JULY 2024 AT INVERNESS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT STATION #36 – 35 ELA ROAD, INVERNESS ILLINOIS

Commissioner Tiedje called the meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Inverness Fire Protection District to order at 3:00 pm.

Commissioner Tiedje opened the floor for public comment. There were no members of the public present. There were no comments or questions for the Board.
